

• 2019 KMOU ISS (International Summer School)

- ❑ **Period : August 1(Thursday) 2019 to August 14(Wednesday), 2019**
- ❑ Host : Nat'l Korea Maritime & Ocean University
- ❑ Program includes :
Korean language, Culture, Marine Sports, Visit to famous sites etc.
- ❑ Two academic credits provided : Global Culture
- ❑ Official transcript will be issued to students who fully complete.
- ❑ **Official language : English**

• Who is Eligible

- ❑ **Undergraduate students** who are studying at a partner university with KMOU as a full time matriculated students and proficient in English.
- ❑ Notes
 - Students who have never learned Korean language can also apply if they have sufficient command of English.
 - Through the KMOU internal procedures, KMOU will select final candidates if the total number exceeds.
 - **Graduate students(master or doctorate degree courses) are NOT eligible.**

• Application Procedure

- ① **First of all, contact the international office of your university and get an application form.**
- ② Fill out the form and submit it to the international office of your university before the deadline the office set.
※ Deadline from your university to KMOU : May 17(Friday), 2019.
- ③ After the final selection from KMOU, the Certificate of Admission will be issued.
- ④ Final candidates need to apply for a **visa(D-2-8)** at the Korean Embassy or Consulate in your country.
※ KMOU is a Certified University from the Ministry of Education in Korea.

• Program Fees

- ❑ Program fees from partner universities : KRW 300,000
 - ※ Payment shall be made **upon arrival at Korea and in Korean Won only.**
- ❑ KMOU will bear the fees for all cultural excursions, welcome and farewell ceremony etc.
- ❑ Students shall be responsible for travel expenses to/from Korea, daily living expenses and expenses of buying overseas travel insurance(illness, injury and indemnity).
